

FEDERAL UNIVERSITY OF PARAÍBA GRADING SYSTEM

- 1. To pass a course, the student must achieve:
 - I. 75% (seventy-five percent) attendance to didactic activities;
 - II. Final average equal to or over 5 (five).
- 2. The academic performance will be expressed by a grade between 0 (zero) and 10 (ten), assigned to each partial test, to the final exam, and to the average resulting from them.
- 3. To pass a course with no need to take the final exam, the student must:
 - I. Achieve the minimum attendance required for the didactic activities; and
 - II. Achieve the arithmetic mean of the grades of academic exercises equal to or over 7 (seven).
- 4. To be entitled to the final exam the student must achieve the minimum attendance required for the didactic activities as well as reach the arithmetic mean of at least 4 (four) on the academic exercises.
- 5. In case the arithmetic mean of the grades achieved by the student on the partial tests lies below 4 (four), the grade obtained by him/her will be recorded as the final score for that course in that semester.
- 6. The final exam will consist of one test after the end of the academic period, which shall test the entire content of the course.
- 7. To pass the final exam, the student must obtain a weighted average equal to or over 5 (five), which will be calculated by assigning weight 6 (six) to the average of academic exercises and weight 4 (four) to the final exam.
- 8. CRA = Coefficient of Academic Performance = $\sum (M_i D_i) / F_c$ Where:

 M_i = final average of the course i

 D_i = number of hours of the course i

 F_c = total number of hours of the finished courses
